4.1 Brian Grice - Overview of the Proposed Community Safety and Well-Being Plan

Brian Grice, Community Safety and Wellbeing Supervisor appeared before the Board and provided an overview of the proposed Community Safety and Well-Being Plan. He reviewed the status of identified goals within the previous Community Safety and Well-Being Plan and summarized the timeline of the proposed plan. B. Grice further reviewed the key findings of the public engagement campaign and outlined the five prioritized risk factors which will be the focus of the 2025 plan. B. Grice concluded with outlining the evaluation, governance, reporting, and next steps of the 2025 plan.


