## **BY-LAW NUMBER xxx-17**

## THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF BRANT

To amend By-law Number 61-16, the Zoning By-law for the County of Brant, as amended (Gerrit Zylstra, 160 King Street, Burford).

**WHEREAS** an application was received from Gerrit Zylstra, Owner of lands described as Plan 727 Lot 25, Burford, County of Brant, located at 160 King Street to amend By-Law Number 61-16, to change the present Suburban Residential Zone (SR) to Special Exception Suburban Residential Zone (SR-\_\_) to allow for continuation of a bike sale and repair shop *use* as a residential *home occupation*;

**AND WHEREAS** the <u>Planning Act</u> empowers a municipality to pass by-laws prohibiting the use of land and the erection, location and use of buildings or structures, except as set out in the by-law;

**AND WHEREAS** this by-law is in conformity with the Official Plan for the County of Brant;

**AND WHEREAS** the Planning Advisory Committee of the Corporation of the County of Brant has recommended approval of this by-law;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the County of Brant deems it to be desirable for the future development and use of the lands described above;

## NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF BRANT HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. **THAT** Schedule 'A', Key Map 108 & 108B of By-law Number 61-16 is hereby amended by changing the zoning on the subject lands from Suburban Residential Zone (SR) to Special Exception Suburban Residential Zone (SR-\_\_), as shown on Schedule "A" of this by-law.
- 2. **THAT** Section 9.3 Special Exceptions SR Zone, is hereby amended by adding the following:

Notwithstanding any provisions of this By-Law to the contrary, within any area zoned SR-\_\_ on Schedule "A" hereto, in addition to the *uses* permitted in the Suburban Residential (SR) Zone, the sale and repair of bicycles shall also be permitted as a *home occupation* subject to the following regulations:

- (a) The use shall be permitted in the detached accessory structure.
- (b) No more than 30 bicycles shall be permitted to be displayed on the property for sale or storage.
- (c) Open storage related to the display of bicycles shall only be permitted in the rear yard between April 1 to October 31 of each year as shown on the attached Schedule "E".

All other requirements of the By-Law shall apply. (Maps 108 & 108B)

3.	<b>THAT</b> this by-law shall come into force on the day it is passed by the Council of the Corporation of the County of Brant.
	<b>READ</b> a first and second time, this day of 2017.
	<b>READ</b> a third time and finally passed in Council, this day of 2017.
