To amend By-law Number 61-16, the Zoning By-law for the County of Brant, as amended, (Armstrong Management on behalf of Illett Farms Ltd, 239 & 241 Highway #5).

WHEREAS an application was received from agent for Ross Ilett Farms Ltd., c/o Ross Ilett, applicant of CON 3 PT LOT 9, Geographic Former Township of South Dumfries, County of Brant, located at 239 & 241 Highway #5, proposing to amend the County of Brant Zoning By-law 61-16 from Agricultural (A) to Special Exemption Agricultural (A-9) to prohibit a dwelling as a permitted use & to modify the zoning boundary of the existing Agricultural Employment (AE-22) to satisfy conditions of consent application B1/19/DN.

AND WHEREAS the <u>Planning Act</u> empowers a municipality to pass by-laws prohibiting the use of land and the erection, location and use of buildings or structures, except as set out in the by-law:

- 1. **THAT** Schedule 'A' of By-law Number 61-16 is hereby amended by changing the zoning on the subject lands from Agricultural (A) to Special Exemption Agricultural (A-9), as shown on Schedule "A" of this by-law.
- 2. **THAT** Schedule 'A' of By-law Number 61-16 is hereby amended by changing the zoning on the subject lands from Agricultural (A) to Special Exemption Agricultural Employment (AE-22), as shown on Schedule "A" of this by-law.
- 3. **THAT** Schedule 'A' of By-law Number 61-16 is hereby amended by changing the zoning on the subject lands from Special Exemption Agricultural Employment (AE-22) to Agricultural (A), as shown on Schedule "A" of this by-law.
- 4. **THAT** this by-law shall come into force on the day it is passed by the Council of the Corporation of the County of Brant.
