As you are aware, a vitural open house was held by LandSquared an a vitual public meeting held by the County. Additional information has been provided to the Planner. This next meeting is when Planning and Development Committee will consider "support" or "no support" for the proposed tower. The final decision is with ISED. There are no appeal apportunities.

LandSquared has looked at alternative locations and has determined that the proposed location is the best in order to obtain coverage and to avoid the natural heritage feature. LandSquared is also willing to reduce the height of the tower to 60m which will reduce the required setback.
