

BY-LAW NUMBER 114-22

THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF BRANT

To appoint inspectors pursuant to the Good Forestry Practices By-law (70-21)

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 15(1) of the Police Services Act, being Chapter P15, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, authority is vested in Council to appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality;

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 435 of the Municipal Act, 2001 S.O. 2001, C 25, a municipality has the power to pass by-laws providing that the municipality may enter on land at any reasonable time for the purpose of carrying out an inspection to determine whether or not a bylaw, direction or order of the municipality is being complied with and further that the power of entry shall be exercised by an employee, officer or agent of the municipality or a member of the police force;

AND WHEREAS the County of Brant Good Forestry Practices By-law prohibits and regulates the destruction and injuring of trees and grants the powers of entry and inspection and the power to issue orders to Inspectors that are designated, appointed and authorized by Council to administer or enforce the provisions of the Good Forestry Practices By-laws;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF BRANT HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. **THAT** Meghan Hunter and Trent Meyers be appointed as inspectors for the purpose of administering and enforcing the County of Brant Good Forestry Practices By-law;
2. **THAT** this By-law comes into force and take effect upon passage.

READ a first and second time, this 22nd day of November, 2022.

READ a third time and finally passed in Council, this 22nd day of November, 2022.
