SCOR EDC came together because councils of the day recognized that a strong memberbased partnership would benefit their individual counties and the region in the long term
















Our Focus

This program includes significant handson experience in safely performing basic machine maintenance and operation of various pieces of agricultural equipment. This practical experience is complemented with the related theory in addition to math, communications, safety, and welding courses. By the end of the program, you will be well-prepared for success as you enter employment in agriculture as an equipment operator.

■ Graduate Opportunities

Graduates will find employment opportunities in a broad cross-section of Agricultural operations including cash crop farms, orchards, beef, dairy, and poultry operations. Additional opportunities will be found with custom farming businesses such as large-scale spraying and fertilizing operations, custom tillage, and harvesting operations


